notation of that fact. The superintendent of the state highway
patrol shall ensure that the law enforcement automated data system
is so configured as to permit the transmission through the system

(I) A sheriff shall accept a completed application form or
renewal application, and the fee, items, materials, and
information specified in divisions (B)(1) to (5) or division (F)
of this section, whichever is applicable, at any time during
normal business hours. In no case shall a sheriff require an
appointment, or designate a specific period of time, for the
submission or acceptance of completed application forms or renewal
applications or the fee, items, materials, and information
specified in divisions (B)(1) to (5) or division (F) of this
section, whichever is applicable, or for the provision to any
person of an application form or renewal application and a copy of
the pamphlet described in division (B) of section 109.731 of the

(J) If a sheriff issues a license or renews a license to
carry a concealed handgun pursuant to this section, not later than
sixty days before the expiration date of the license, the sheriff
shall notify the licensee, in writing, of the upcoming expiration
of the license. The notice required by this division shall be sent
to the licensee by regular mail at the licensee's last known
residence address. The notice shall inform the licensee of the
expiration date of the license, of the procedure for renewing the
license, and of the fact that the license must be renewed not
later than thirty days after the specified expiration date and
that that thirty-day period is a grace period during which the
license remains valid. The duty imposed by this division applies
regarding all licenses to carry a concealed handgun issued or
